


Using OverDrive in a browser

Step One: From the top of the Library's homepage, click "Online Resources"




Step Two: Navigate to, and click on "OverDrive eBooks". Then scroll down until you see "Click here to enter OverDrive":







Step Three: By clicking the link in the above steps, you are taken to the Kentucky Libraries Unbound website. Here, in the top right hand corner of the page, you will need to click “Sign In”, then select the library from the drop down list.




After the library is selected, you will be taken to a log in page that requests your library card number and your PIN. **You PIN is the last four digits of the phone number you gave the library when you set up your account.**



You are then directed to the home page where you can borrow eBooks, audiobooks, movies, and music. You can even create a wish list for when you've borrowed your limit and would like to remember that borrow that material in the future by clicking the "ribbon" beside the text "Add to Wishlist" as shown below. When you find a material that you are interested in borrowing, just click "Borrow".



After clicking borrow, you will be presented with two options: Download the eBook as a file, or Read it in your browser. To download the book as a file, you will have to have preinstalled the OverDrive Media Console on your computer.



Reading the book in your browser is incredibly easy to do, and when you first open the book, you are presented with a short “how-to” to help you become accustomed to the ins and outs of the browser reader.
